AFTER THE EXAMS
Advice for Students and Parents



After the Yr 10 exams students are required, by law, to be at school every day to complete a program of events in addition to scheduled learning activities. The overview of programmed events is printed on the back of this page.

Week 6 - Commencing on Monday 15th November students, depending on their classes, will be involved in CPR training or emergency care training or the compulsory Board of Studies module “HSC All My Own Work”. This module is compulsory for all students wishing to commence Yr 11 and 12. Normal lessons as outlined below are followed at all other times. On Thursday and Friday students will present their Quality Portfolio (and are not required at school except for their interview time).

Week 7 - depending on their classes, students will be involved in CPR training or emergency care training or the compulsory Board of Studies module “All My Own Work”. Normal lessons as outlined below are followed at all other times. Excursion to Tweed movie theatre on Friday (cost to students).

Week 8 - depending on their classes, students will be involved in CPR training or the compulsory Board of Studies module “All My Own Work”. Normal lessons as outlined below are followed at all other times. Year 10 clearance forms commence this week during class time. Thursday and Friday all year 10 students will be involved in peer support training in preparation for their roles as mentors to year 7 students. This will be offsite at no cost to students.

Week 9 - Normal lessons as outlined below are followed. Clearance is to be completed by Tuesday. Assembly will be conducted 9am on Friday in the Gym. Parents are invited to attend assembly and the morning tea. Students may then leave with their parents.
